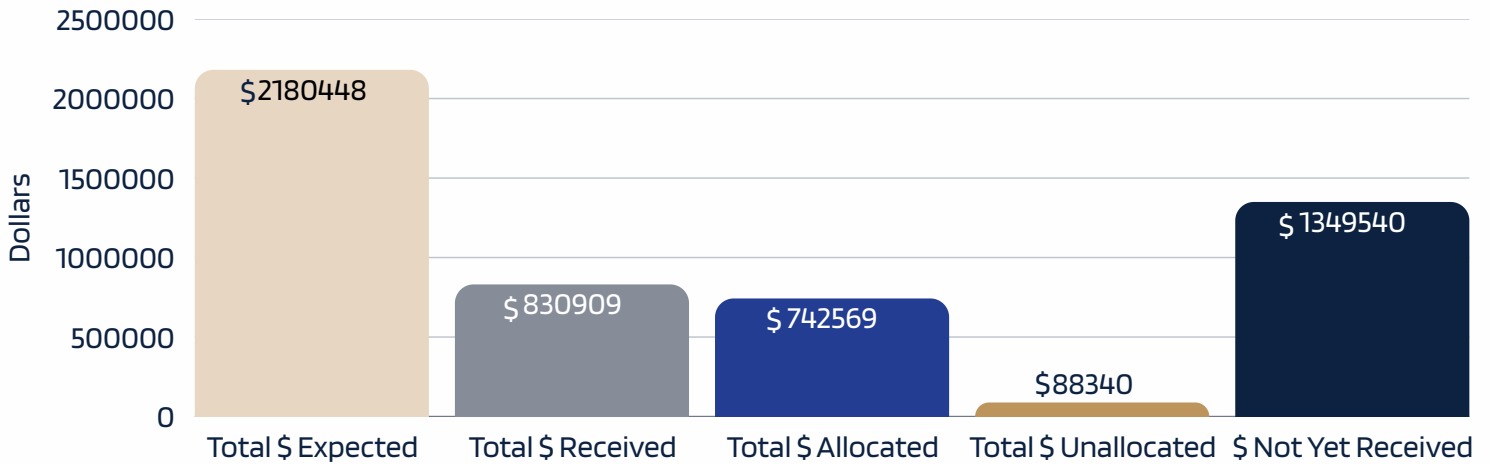
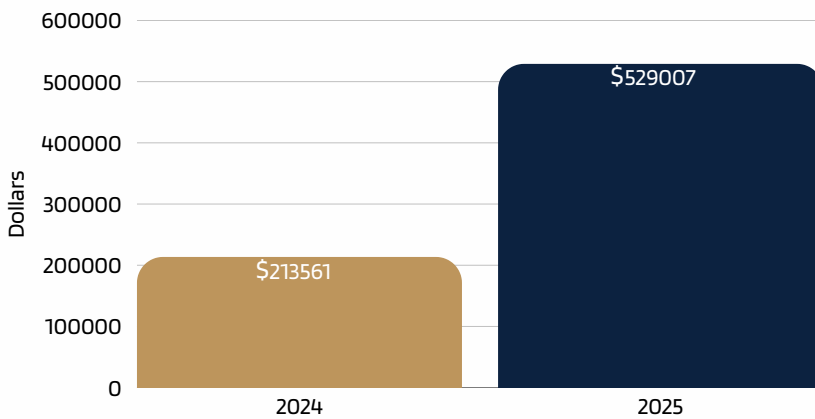


Douglas County Opioid Allocations Overview 2023-2025

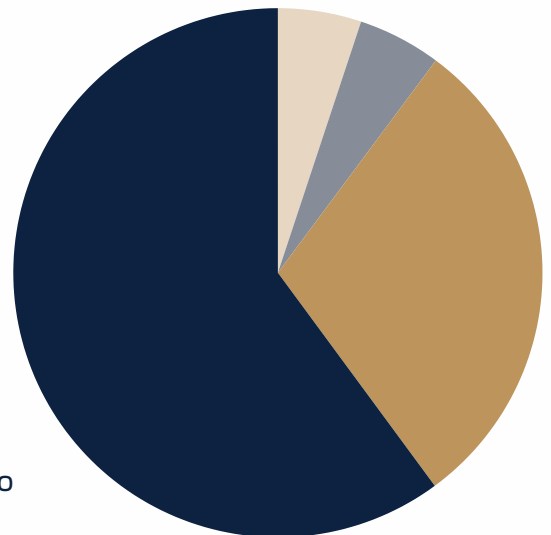


Allocations by Year

Unity Recovery, Treatment & Recovery

Title: Annual Alexandria Area Recovery Resource Fair

Funding Award: \$2,500, **Start Project Period:** 4/2/2024

Summary: Connect people in recovery, their families, and the broader community with local service providers, education, and peer support to reduce stigma and strengthen recovery networks.

Unity Recovery, Treatment & Recovery, **Title: Unity Recovery Community Engagement Project**

Funding Award: \$5,000, **Start Project Period:** 5/7/2024

Summary: Unity Recovery will partner with WEcovery Alexandria to host free, stigma-reducing recreational and recovery events that foster connection, support people in treatment and recovery, and strengthen community engagement across Douglas County.

Douglas County Sheriff, Law Enforcement & Criminal Justice, **Title: Non-Contact Substance Identification Initiative**

Funding Award: \$29,975, **Start Project Period:** 7/2/2024

Summary: Purchased Detectachem Apex Raman Spectrometer to test unknown substances without removing them from packaging or surface to reduce exposures..

Advocates For Health, Harm Reduction, **Title:** AED & Narcan Cabinets

Funding Award: \$30,000, **Start Project Period:** 12/17/2024

Summary: Install public safety cabinets in downtown Alexandria equipped with AEDs & naloxone, paired with community training and outreach, to improve overdose and cardiac arrest response & reduce opioid-related harms.

Horizon Public Health, Prevention & Early Intervention, **Title:** Opioid Media Campaign

Funding Award: \$11,856, **Start Project Period:** 12/17/2024

Summary: A county-wide communications campaign using digital media, materials, and community events to prevent substance misuse, reduce stigma, delay initiation, and promote local prevention and treatment resources.

Horizon Public Health, Prevention & Early Intervention, **Title:** Healthy Voices Healthy Choices Expansion Coalition

Funding Award: \$53,550, **Start Project Period:** 12/17/2024

Summary: The Healthy Voices Healthy Choices Coalition, led by Horizon Public Health, will expand prevention efforts in Douglas County by empowering youth leaders, fostering community conversations to reduce stigma, piloting mental well-being and alternative-to-suspension programs in schools, and promoting safer vape disposal, with the overall goal of reducing opioid misuse and strengthening community resilience.

Beyond Brink, Treatment & Recovery, **Title:** Harm Reduction Support

Funding Award: \$80,680. **Start Project Period:** 12/17/2024

Summary: Collaboration with MN Harm Reduction project to provide wrap around services, resource navigation, education and outreach..

Kalon Prep Academy, Prevention & Early Intervention, **Title:** Youth Prevention Programming

Funding Award: \$50,800, **Start Project Period:** 1/21/2025

Summary: The Kalon Prep Academy project seeks to prevent youth substance misuse by fostering positive childhood experiences through extracurricular activities, wellness programming, and supportive staffing, creating healthier outlets and resilience for students.

Bridgeway, Prevention & Early Intervention, **Title:** Academic Transition & Accountability Support

Funding Award: \$55,764, **Start Project Period:** 9/2/2025

Summary: Support a full-time Career Readiness Intervention Paraprofessional responsible for monitoring daily readiness scores, identifying at-risk students, and coordinating interventions with staff and families.

Douglas County Jail, Prevention & Early Intervention, **Title:** Holding Cell Overdose Monitoring & Prevention Project

Funding Award: \$68,447, **Start Project Period:** 9/2/2025

Summary: Sensors for 6 holding cells to be able to monitor individuals at high-risk for overdose when in jail.

Solutions Behavioral Health, Treatment & Recovery, **Title:** SUD/LADC Development Project

Funding Award: \$193,996, **Start Project Period:** 9/2/2025

Summary: Expand evidence-based opioid use disorder treatment by certifying as an SUD provider, hiring additional LADCs, and offering comprehensive outpatient, telehealth, case management, family support, and community training services.

Unity Recovery, Treatment & Recovery, **Title:** Unity Recovery Community Engagement Project

Funding Award: \$10,000, **Start Project Period:** 9/2/2025

Summary: Partner with WEcovery Alexandria to host free, stigma-reducing recreational and recovery events that foster connection, support people in treatment and recovery, and strengthen community engagement.

West Central MN Community Action, Treatment & Recovery, **Title:** Rental Assistance & Outreach

Funding Award: \$150,000, **Start Project Period:** 9/2/2025

Summary: A comprehensive, trauma-informed approach to support people in treatment and recovery, preventing opioid misuse, & reducing overdose deaths by combining housing navigation, case management, harm reduction, community partnerships, and culturally relevant outreach.
