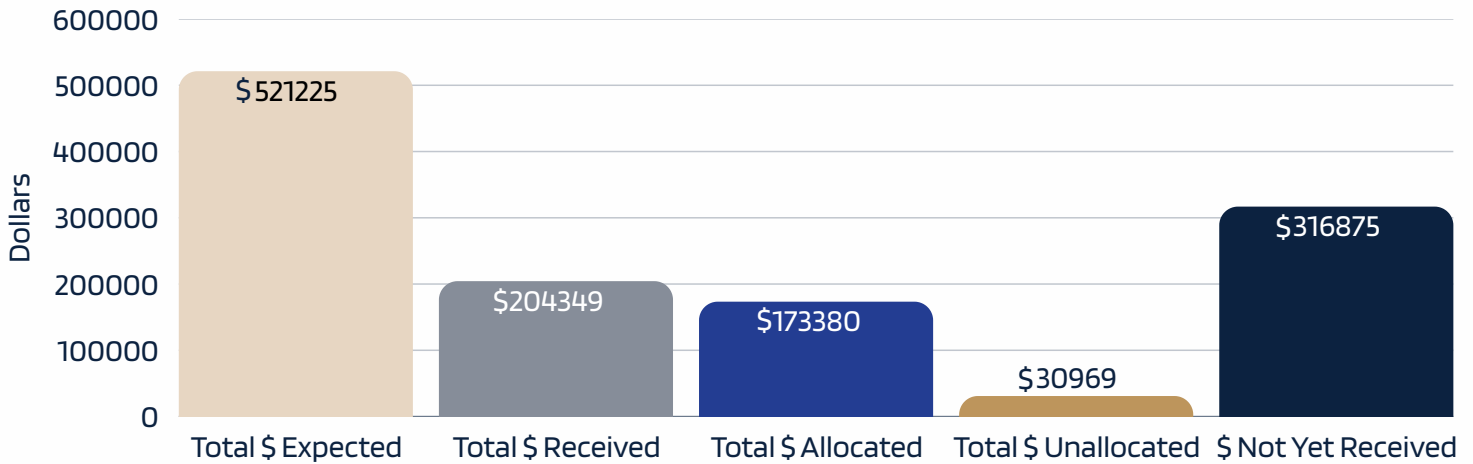
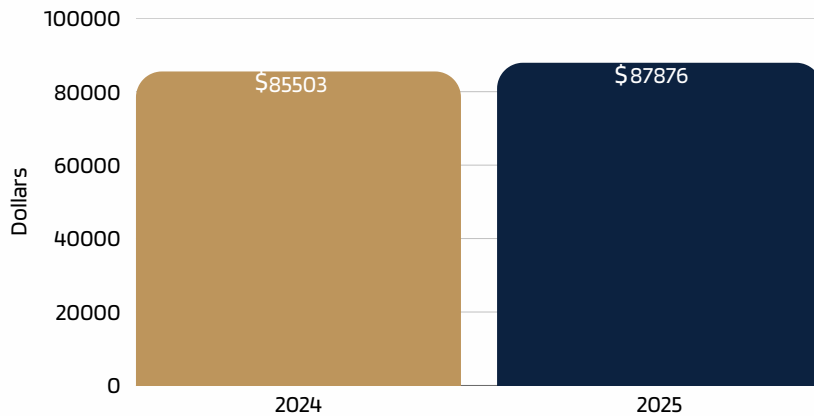


Stevens County Opioid Allocations Overview 2023-2025

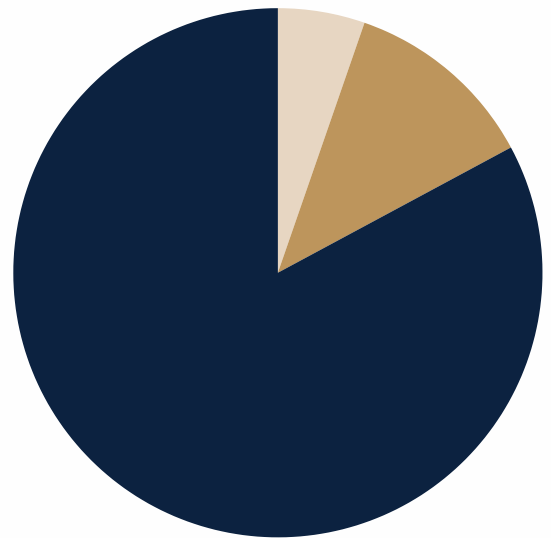


Allocations by Year

Project Details

Stevens County Medical Center, Treatment & Recovery

Title: SCMC Opioid Treatment and Training Expansion

Funding Award: \$72,063, **Start Project Period:** 2/6/2024

Summary: Stevens Community Medical Center will expand local treatment capacity by training providers in addiction medicine, trauma therapies (EMDR and Brainspotting), and licensing a new alcohol and drug counselor, ensuring evidence-based care, reduced stigma, and sustainable OUD treatment access in rural west-central Minnesota..

Unity Recovery, Treatment & Recovery, Title: Unity Recovery Support Project

Funding Award: \$1,584, **Start Project Period:** 2/6/2024

Summary: Unity Recovery will provide gas cards to rural residents without access to medical rides, reducing transportation barriers to substance use disorder treatment and supporting individuals in recovery.

Stevens County Project Details continued

Horizon Public Health, Prevention & Early Intervention, **Title:** Opioid Media Campaign

Funding Award: \$11,856, **Start Project Period:** 12/17/2024

Summary: A county-wide communications campaign using digital media, materials, and community events to prevent substance misuse, reduce stigma, delay initiation, and promote local prevention and treatment resources.

Stevens Ambulance, Harm Reduction, **Title:** Secure Access for Field Emergency Medications

Funding Award: \$9,206, **Start Project Period:** 8/5/2025

Summary: The Stevens County Ambulance Service project will use opioid settlement funds to purchase secure narcotic safes and ventilator accessories, improving medication security, patient safety, and overdose response capacity in rural EMS operations.

RUSC Kinship, Prevention & Early Intervention, **Title:** NEAR Presentations

Funding Award: \$720, **Start Project Period:** 8/5/2025

Summary: Expand mentoring, outreach, and family support programs to prevent substance misuse, reduce stigma, and strengthen protective factors for youth and families impacted by the opioid epidemic.

Vivie, Prevention & Early Intervention, **Title:** PEARLS Program

Funding Award: \$7,950. **Start Project Period:** 8/5/2025

Summary: PEARLS is an evidence-based, community-delivered program that equips older adults with tools to manage depression and build healthier lives while expanding access to mental health care in underserved and rural communities through trained coaches, interns, and bilingual support.

Car Care, Treatment & Recovery, **Title:** Transportation for Opioid Affected Individuals

Funding Award: \$35,000, **Start Project Period:** 8/5/2025

Summary: Support individuals in recovery by repairing vehicles, donating vehicles, partnering with treatment centers to identify needs, and offering mentorship and training through the Spark Plug Gang.

West Central MN Community Action, Treatment & Recovery, **Title:** Rental Assistance Outreach

Funding Award: \$35,000, **Start Project Period:** 8/5/2025

Summary: A comprehensive, trauma-informed approach to support people in treatment and recovery, prevents opioid misuse, and reduces overdose deaths by combining housing navigation, case management, harm reduction, community partnerships, and culturally relevant outreach.
